Comments: This copper and manganese bearing tourmaline may be called "paraíba tourmaline" in the trade. The name "paraíba" comes from the Brazilian locality where this gem was first mined, however today it may come from several localities.

This stone exhibits a change of color when viewed under daylight or fluorescent vs incandescent light.
